Balice International Airport (KRK) is the main gateway with direct flights from the most relevant cities all over the world. From Balice airport to Krakow city center there are bus connections and train shuttle leaving every 30 minutes (duration 35', 17 PLN).

The easiest way to get from the center of Krakow to the conference venue is by tram, which leaves every few minutes (Tram stop: Uniwersytet Komisji Edukacji Narodowej).

Similarly, almost all Polish and European destinations are connected to Krakow by trains stopping at Kraków Main Station (Kraków Główny). Kraków Główny railway station and nearby UKEN are conveniently served by an efficient network of bus, trams, and taxis.
